LA THUILE

MTB NATURAL TRAIL AREA

The Funivie Piccolo San Bernardo S.p.A. offers all MTB enthusiasts the possibility to go up the mountain via the **Bosco Express and Chalet Express chairlifts**, together with their bikes.

By purchasing the **International Pass** at the "Yellow-Blue Point" of the cable cars, you also get access via a single ticket to the French ski lifts of **La Rosière** for boundless bike rides through some of the most spectacular passes in the Alps such as the Piccolo San Bernardo pass (2,188 asl).

The **MTB Natural Trail Area** of **La Thuile**, theater of the fourth stage of the **Enduro World Series** in 2014, 2016 and 2018; it extends over a large area that, **starting from an elevation of 2,600 m** at the foot of the Chaz Dura ridges, goes down for over 1,200 m in altitude to the village of La Thuile, for a total of **220 km of paths** and accessible itineraries.

MOUNTAIN BIKE FOR EVERYONE

Those who choose the **MTB Natural Trail Area of La Thuile** give themselves an extraordinary travel companion: the **majestic scenery of the highest peaks in Europe**, including Mont Blanc, the Rosa group, the Matterhorn and other imposing Alpine peaks.

The paths of La Thuile, largely created from ancient walkways in full respect of nature and of the landscape, cross areas rich in interesting historical evidence such as the mining area and the Piccolo San Bernardo pass.

The **map** of the MTB Natural Trail Area of La Thuile indicates **all the itineraries that can be traveled by bike**, divided according to the type and degree of difficulty. The special signs along the paths, on the other hand, help with orientation during the excursions.

The MTB Natural Trail Area of La Thuile was developed to satisfy bikers of all levels and characteristics and to allow a gradual improvement in and development of biking skills and techniques.

The **great difference in elevation** is one of the prominent features of the trail area, largely covered by the ski lifts open from late June to late August. There are also beautiful roads and rideable mule tracks that reach truly fascinating secluded spots and places.

The **paths** of the Natural Trail Area of La Thuile are classified as follows:

Very Easy: indicated on the map in **green**; these are flat paths and practically free of obstacles, suitable for families or beginners.

Easy: indicated on the map in **blue**; these are wide and easily rideable paths, but suitable for those who already have basic biking knowledge. There are small obstacles and climbs.

Difficult: indicated on the map in **red**; these are mainly downhill gravity trails that go into the woods. Traveling on them, it is necessary to have good biking skills. There are artificial and natural obstacles.

Very difficult: indicated on the map in **black**; these are highly technical gravity paths exclusively prepared for expert bikers. They cover great differences in elevation; they are long, with several sloping sections full of obstacles.

Electric Bike: indicated on the map in **purple**; these are itineraries on asphalt and dirt roads that leave the town and go up the mountain slopes. They are routes marked as "Electric Bike" but they can also be easily traveled with a normal mountain bike and normal training.

Transfers: indicated on the map in **yellow**; these are white roads open to the traffic of vehicles, horses and pedestrians which can be used by bikers to reach a trail or to move to another part of the Bike Area. The utmost attention is required when traveling these stretches.

PASS: Different types of **passes** are available at the Piccolo San Bernardo cable cars, including the **international** one, a **single ticket** with which you can use both the Italian and French ski lifts of La Rosière.

FACILITIES

A well-equipped **School Camp**, coordinated by the instructors of the La Thuile Mountain Bike School; it is located in the Planibel area, near the departure point of the Bosco Express chairlift. It is equipped with various trails including the preparatory structures of the **skill park**, to develop balance in riding and a correct position on the bike. This space is enriched with a **dual slalom** track and the brand new **push bike** (bike without pedals) project for the very young

BICYCLE: Free transportation on the Bosco Express and Chalet Express chairlifts for valid ticket holders.

SMALL AND MEDIUM-SIZE DOGS can get on the Bosco Express and Chalet Express chairlifts at a cost of €4.00 per day!

Tickets are valid on the La Thuile or La Rosière chairlifts during the opening periods as follows:

- Morning: ticket is valid on the Bosco Express and Chalet Express chairlifts until 1 pm
- Afternoon: ticket is valid from 1 pm until closing on the Bosco Express and Chalet Express chairlifts.
- La Thuile daily pass: pass is valid all day during the opening hours of the La Thuile chairlifts.
- Espace daily pass: pass is valid all day during the opening hours of the La Thuile and La Rosière chairlifts.
- La Thuile summer season ticket: ticket is valid without limits, every day and during the opening hours of the La Thuile chairlifts (Bosco Express and Chalet Express chairlifts).

NB: INTERNATIONAL CONNECTION

it is recommended to use vehicles such as cars and/or minibuses via State Road 26 towards Colle del Piccolo San Bernardo or via cross country bikes/e-bikes. Check the dates and opening times of the chairlifts on the French side.

PILA

PILA BIKELAND

Pila is the perfect location both for those preparing for their "**baptism in the saddle**", and for expert bikers, as well as for professional athletes. Pila has a vast area suitable for all levels of ability and is organized along routes of varying difficulty. The ski lifts have been equipped with special hooks that allow you to **transport bikes for free**, reaching a higher elevation without effort. The bikes can be loaded directly in Aosta.

CROSS-COUNTRY: Pila's network of farm roads is vast and satisfies everyone, from aspiring champions to families thanks to itineraries ranging from 2,300 to 600 m. of elevation satisfying both the pleasure of cycling in peace and tranquility as well as the expectations of those looking for technical and challenging trails.

The colors guide you in choosing the level of difficulty:

- blue = easy
- red = medium difficulty
- black = difficult

The marked routes foresee the use of ski lifts. (see cross-country Pila map)

BIKE STADIUM: The Bike Stadium consists of **16 Downhill** and **freeride tracks** with several **variants** of descent by mountain bike with varying degrees of difficulty. The Downhill track is an important venue for international competitions.

The freeride and freeride extreme tracks are mainly on natural soil.

FREERIDE: The freeride trails are mainly on natural soil and present difficulties that alternate from easy to difficult in the various sections, and are marked by indications of the degrees of difficulty.

You can find freeride tracks inside the BikeStadium as well as the beautiful Pila - Aosta slope and the Desarpa Bike trail.

PILA - AOSTA FREERIDE: The Pila - Aosta route, unique in its kind, is suitable for all freeride enthusiasts; it has a length of 8 km on a difference in elevation of 1,170 meters, which can increase up to **11 km** on an overall difference in elevation of 1730 meters, taking advantage of the trails already present on the upper part of the trail.

DESARPA BIKE: The "Desarpa" trail starts from the point of arrival of the Couis 1 chairlift and allows you to descend to the valley as far as Aosta (about **15 km** with a difference in elevation of **2,100 m**). After the second curve, turn left towards the Couis 2 station of arrival.

Continue along the trail to the point from where the Grimod chairlift departs. At this point the trail enters a grove and reaches the Plan Bois area, where the dirt road ends. After the square of the station at the bottom of the Leissé chairlift and continue on the Freeride trail that leads to Aosta.

CHAMOLÉ AND COUIS 1 CHAIRLIFT: FREE BIKE TRANSPORTATION

PUMP TRACK located at the point of arrival of the Aosta-Pila gondola lift

Bumps, compressions and parabolas make up the oval-shaped trail suitable not only for the fun of adults and children alike, but also as a training ground for downhill bikers, as using it makes it possible to develop technical skills, control of the vehicle and of one's body.

Inside the PumpTrack there is no "pedaling": the pedals in fact only serve as a support while the speed is managed using the movement of the body and the shifting of the center of gravity forward or backward in correspondence with the compressions as if you were "pumping". Even the curves and the parabolas allow you to increase your pace thanks to the right position of the body and the correct use of the bike.

Access to the PumpTrack is free and open to a maximum of 5 users at a time who must:

- use the indicated entrance
- respect the obligatory direction of travel
- respect the right-of-way of bikers who are already on the track
- use the appropriate exit gate.

The alternation of people inside the facility is guaranteed by the physical and aerobic effort required in using it: breaks for rest and recovery are, in fact, frequent.

All types of mountain bikes are allowed inside the PumpTrack as long as the bicycle is in good condition. Protective helmet and body protectors are mandatory. For all the details you can refer to the regulations downloadable from this page and available on site.

If you don't have your own bike (or if you are not sure about the condition of yours) or if you do not have the necessary protective equipment, don't worry: you will find everything at the rental store adjacent to the PumpTrack

TORGNON

ADRENALINE ON TWO WHEELS, FOR EVERYONE WITH THE EASY DOWNHILL TRAIL.

The route can be reached by chairlift, which can also carry bicycles, and it is also suitable for children thanks to a low-to-average slope. The track devoted to the activity is 4.5km long, it starts from Collet (2258 meters above sea level) and arrives at the Basin of Chantorné, at an altitude of 1,850 meters, with a vertical drop of 400 meters.

The entire trail has an average slope of 6.40%, with peaks of 17%: also ideal for challenging yourself in safety and for trying out an adventure that is suitable for children as well.
